

Conditions

- Participation in the Phuket Draw costs £10 per ticket.
- The raffle is open to residents of mainland Great Britain (this excludes Northern Ireland, Isle of Man and Channel Islands).

- No tickets can be sold to, on behalf of, or for a person under the age of 16 years.
